The Hortobágy Wild Animal Park is based on the natural conditions of the Hortobágy National Park and is a perfect place for the demonstration of the ancient wildlife of the Hungarian Puszta. The Hortobágy Wild Animal Park presents some of the animals that had been living here before the appearance of man, but were driven to extinction by the spread of civilization like for example wolves, jackals, Przewalski's horses, reconstructed aurochs and vultures. Visitors can also observe wild animals that are still living in the protected areas such as wildcats, foxes, roe deer, polecats, white-tailed eagles, cranes and great white egrets. The wildlife park offers various programs for the whole family. An exhibition about the ancient wild life of the puszta, a souvenir shop with buffet and a play ground are also available in the wild animal park. The natural-like spacious enclosures offer excellent opportunities for photographers.

The large grazing animals can be observed closely during an extra safari program. Visitors can book a trip with a land rover with expert guidance to the wild horses and aurochs. The program is charged separately and lasts about 25 minutes, maximum 7 persons can join in one turn. The extra safari depends on the weather conditions.
